The post-holder will sit as a member of the Court of Appeal of the Cayman Islands hearing appeals from the Grand Court. The post-holder will be one of a team of Court of Appeal Judges (including the President of the Court of Appeal) and must be prepared to rotate a minimum of two sittings annually.

It is essential that the post-holder has expertise in company and/or commercial and/or insolvency law and/or judicial review. Some experience of criminal law is desirable. Judicial experience at an appellate level is also highly desirable.

In addition, the post-holder for this position must:-

- hold or have held a high judicial office in the British Commonwealth;
- possess a sound and thorough knowledge of the general common law and the ability to interpret local legislation and case law in making decisions in accordance with the laws of the Cayman Islands;
- have the ability to exercise good judgment and commitment and to be conscientious and to work diligently;
- possess excellent research, analytical, oral and written skills together with basic computer skills;
- be able to command the respect of the legal profession and the community, and possess absolute personal integrity;
- be able to demonstrate procedural fairness in all cases and deal tactfully and courteously with all participants, as well as with the public; and
- be a person of maturity and sound judgment, possessing strong communication and listening skills and be able to manage time efficiently.

The post holder will be subject to a Code of Conduct promulgated by the Judicial and Legal Services Commission.

The successful candidate will receive an appointment for a fixed term ending not later than age 75 years. That term may be extended to end not later than the age of 78 years.

Benefits include government funded airfare, accommodation and transportation of an appropriate standard. In addition, a gratuity in the amount of 5% at end of contract calculated on the annual retainer and daily fees awarded.
