

**The Cayman Islands Judicial and Legal Services Commission invites  
EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST FOR AD HOC APPOINTMENT AS  
ACTING JUDGE OF APPEAL**

Due to increased demand for special sittings of the Court of Appeal, the Judicial and Legal Services Commission (“JLSC”) invites expressions of interest from suitably qualified persons who may be considered for ad hoc appointment by the Governor, pursuant to section 102(2) of the Constitution set out in Schedule 2 to the Cayman Islands Constitution Order 2009, to sit on the Court of Appeal as acting Judges from time to time as required.

Any such appointment would ordinarily be for the hearing of a specific appeal and would include pre- and post-hearing work.

Selection will be based upon a statement from the applicant setting out their experience, and a CV. It is not anticipated that interviews will take place. The names of two referees (who may not necessarily be approached) should also be provided.

Persons appointed to sit on the Court of Appeal pursuant to section 102(2) will be remunerated at established daily rates for sitting, preparatory reading and research.

Benefits will include a government funded airfare, accommodation and transportation of an appropriate standard.

It is essential that any applicant has proven expertise in chancery and/or commercial and/or insolvency law and has judicial experience at a high, preferably appellate, level.

In addition, the applicant must:

- hold or have held a high judicial office in the British Commonwealth;
- possess a sound and thorough knowledge of the general common law and the ability to interpret local legislation and case law in making decisions in accordance with the laws of the Cayman Islands;
- be able to exercise good judgment and commitment;
- possess excellent research, analytical, oral and written skills together with basic computer skills;
- be able to command the respect of the legal profession and the community, and possess absolute personal integrity;
- be able to demonstrate procedural fairness in all cases and deal tactfully and courteously with all participants, as well as with the public;
- be a person of maturity and sound judgment, possessing strong communication and listening skills and be able to manage time efficiently; and
- be able to work cooperatively with colleagues in a small court centre.

Appointees will be subject to the Code of Conduct promulgated by the JLSC.

Applicants will also be subject to the normal background checks.
